She also serves as Vice-President of the Academic Board, providing leadership across a wide spectrum of academic activity including university governance, the scholarship of learning and teaching, and research within the arts and education.

Cecilia's love of music blossomed early; she first performed on stage at four, and by six had already won her first grand trophy. A devoted church musician throughout her youth, she served as a cantor in her local parish in the Philippines and soon earned national recognition in prestigious solo voice competitions.



In 2000, Cecilia became a six-time television singing champion, captivating audiences across the Philippines. Her musical path then led her to Japan, where she performed for Club Med — an adventure that broadened her artistry and introduced her to her husband.

A long-time member of the Mackay Choral Society, Cecilia treasures the joy, community, and lifelong friendships she has found within the choir. She is also deeply committed to mentoring young musicians through Holy Spirit College's Music Ministry, a role she has lovingly fulfilled for more than a decade.
